### FROMAGER

**BOTANICAL NAMES**

Ceiba pentandra.

**ORIGINS FAMILY**

It belongs to the family of Bombacaceae.

**GROWTH AREA**

This tree grows below the ground of tropical area of the West Africa.

**SPECIFIC WEIGHT**

Green 500 kg/m<sup>3</sup> – Dried 350 kg/m<sup>3</sup> al 12% C.U.

**TECHNOLOGICAL FEATURES**

Sapwood and heartwood are not distinguished;  
The wood is a whitish-yellow or greyish-yellow color.  
It has a coarse texture and a very variable grain.  
The Fromager is not durable, so it is recommended to treat the wood in order to preserve it from fungi attacks.

**DRYING METHOD**

The wood dries without any particular problems.

**MAIN USES AND WORKING**

This is an easy-to-work wood, nails and screws hold well.  
The Fromager is suitable for all types of indoor work;  
In particular profiles, frames, inlaid objects, plywood, light packaging and wood pulp.
